- Puncture-proof soles should be worn in an area where there are nails, scrap metal or other objects with sharp edges and points
- Metal or composite toe-protectors should be worn if there is a danger of heavy objects falling on your feet
- Chemical resistant boots should be worn near areas where chemicals are being used or stored
- Insulated shoes should be worn to protect your feet against cold temperatures
- Slip Resistant Shoes should be worn in areas where oil and grease accumulate or in areas where there are shavings on the floor that create a slip and fall hazard
