









Using Watchlists

WATCHLISTS HOLD THE VIDEOS YOU HAVE SELECTED FOR VIEWING.

They provide easy access to the videos you need to play during a training session. You can add all your videos to one Watchlist or you can make more Watchlists to hold different groups of training videos.

Multiple Watchlists allow you to create groups of training videos. You can assign one or more Watchlists to Viewers, letting you control which videos your Viewers have access to.

CREATING WATCHLISTS

To create a Watchlist go to Account > Watchlists in the menu bar.

Managing Viewers

WHAT IS A VIEWER?

A Viewer is a special kind of access. Logging in with the Viewer Access Code allows that person to view the already selected videos. They can't browse videos or select videos when logged in with a Viewer Access Code. They can only play the videos selected by a Trainer.

You can use the Viewer Access Code to give employees access to the videos selected by a Trainer. You can have one Viewer Access Code for everyone to use or you can make Viewer Access Codes for as many people as you want to track. Each time a Viewer watches a video that information is logged in the Activity report.


You can also assign Viewers to Watchlists (groups of videos), so you can choose which videos the Viewer has access to.

Activity Reports

ACTIVITY REPORTS TRACK ALL TYPES OF EVENTS.


You can tell who has played the videos you have assigned. You can also see when videos were added to Watchlists and by whom, as well as when Viewers were created.
